

### **RockiesRide**

Be part of the crowd taking the easiest, most exciting way to Coors Field.



With direct service from many RTD Park-n-Rides and Boulder High School, RockiesRide provides convenient bus transportation to all weekend home games, as well as Opening Day, Friday, April 1, and the Annual Fireworks Game, Friday, July 1.

Grab a seat, get comfortable, and enjoy a Colorado baseball tradition.

#### **Routes and fares**

It's simple to take RockiesRide to the game. Just visit our website or call our customer service center for the complete bus schedule. Then hop on the bus at one of our pick up locations and pay your exact fare. The only tickets you need are the ones to the game.

#### **Bus arrivals and departures**

All RockiesRide buses are clearly identified by the route number and the letter "R" (e.g., 5R) on the destination signs on the front of each bus.

RockiesRide buses leave from designated locations up to two hours prior to game time and arrive within 30–60 minutes of the first pitch. Excluding rain delays, buses begin to depart from 22nd and Blake at the conclusion of the game and continue for the next 45 minutes.

#### Alternate service to all home games

Local, Express, and Regional bus routes RTD has many other bus routes that will drop you off just a few blocks from the ballpark. Please check schedules, as some routes offer limited evening and weekend service.

#### Light rail

Catch the C or E light rail lines to Denver Union Station or the D, F, or H lines to the 16th/California or 16th/Stout stations. Then jump on the FREE MallRide to Market Street Station and head toward Coors Field.

All RTD vehicles are wheelchair accessible.



Children five years of age or younger ride free with a fare-paying adult. \*\*Cold Spring Park-n-Ride will permanently close on May 15, 2011 because of West Corridor light rail construction. The new Federal Center Station will open just two blocks south on 2nd Avenue and Routt Street.





RockiesRide Stop Parking is not allowed at Boulder High School unless a school attendant is on duty collecting parking fees.
