

**To assemble rail car**  
Gently remove cutouts from page. Lightly bend all fold lines. Insert numbered tabs in slots with the same number, in sequence. Tape to secure.



For steps 6 and 8 fold tabs as shown in steps 1-3 below, then insert folded tabs into numbered slots on the bottom of rail vehicle.

**9** #9 is the rail vehicle's pantograph, the arm attached to the top of the rail car. The pantograph collects electric current from the overhead wire called a catenary.



Remove pantograph from page, gently bend along fold lines and place in the slots on the roof of the rail vehicle as shown below.
